About Your Privacy

United Way of Kenosha County values your privacy and we realize that visitors to our website may have concerns about privacy and security and is therefore providing the following information explaining our online information practices. The policy may change from time to time. By visiting our site, you agree to the practices detailed in this Privacy Policy.

What information does United Way of Kenosha County gather through the site?

When you visit our site, we collect some non-identifying basic information. This includes total number of visitors, pages viewed, and other non-identifying information. We use this aggregate information to improve our site and to make your experience on our website as smooth as possible. Our website logs are not personally identifiable, and we make no attempt to link them with the individuals that actually browse the site.

Information gathered when making a donation or pledge

To make a donation through the site, you may need to provide certain other information relevant to how you choose to contribute in order to complete your pledge/gift transaction (e.g. If you choose to give by credit card, you will be prompted to provide information such as your credit card number). You also may be required to provide additional registration information to obtain special services or to complete transactions initiated by you (e.g. recording a stated desire to donate online through this site through a company-sponsored campaign).

With whom does United Way of Kenosha County share my personal information?

United Way of Kenosha County will not sell, reveal or share with unaffiliated third parties any of your personally identifiable information except in the following limited circumstances:

- We have your permission to share the information
- We are authorized to do so under this privacy statement, or:
- We are required by law to disclose your information or to protect against fraud or illegal activity.
