



Community Investment Committee (CIC)

Purpose:

To make sound funding decisions based on the United Way of Kenosha County (UWKC) community investment process and in line with United Way's missions and priorities.

Committee Member Responsibilities:

- Attend committee meetings; Review applications, program reports and financial reports from partner providers to ensure responsible stewardship and accountability for funds allocated by United Way
- Be knowledgeable about the programs being reviewed (with information gained through partner provider applications and interviews), as well as the community conditions that affect the work of the partner providers
- Make recommendations regarding specific allocations of the investment committees funding pool
- Participate in assignments as part of a site visit team that includes going on site visits, completing evaluations and sharing information with the team
- Assist in the ongoing improvement of United Way's community investment process

Qualifications:

- Resides and/or works within UWKC's service area
- Possess an understanding of and commitment to community building
- Uses positive communication and shares their expertise in this volunteer role
- Willingness to communicate and review applications online

Time Commitment:

- Estimated 9 monthly meetings (no meetings July, August or December)
- Estimated 25 hours of annual volunteer time including meetings, site visits and preparation.
